Will of John Averie of Chipping Norton, 1577

In the name of god Amen in the yeare of o[u]r Lorde god 1577 the xxiij th daye of Aprill I John Averie of Chippingnorton beinge sycke in body [lowe??] be yt of parfytt memorye doo make this my last wyll & Testa= ment in manner and Forme Followinge Fyrst I bequeath my soule to all mightie god and my bodye to be buryed in the churche of the sayed Chippingnorten It[e]m I give and bequeathe to the churche of Chippingnorton x^{s} It[e]m I give and bequeathe to the poore of this towne xx^s Allso I give and bequeathe to Walter Averye my sonne a dosen of sortinge vessel twoe myddle candlestickes a tynne bason a second brasse pott a cawdren of the myddle sorte a posnett a woorte panne of the myddle sorte a broche a chafyngdyshe a table clothe Allso I give and bequeathe to John trevis a Fetherbed w[i]th all the furniture that belongeth thereto Allso I give and bequeathe to Matthewe trevis xiij^s iiij^d It[e]m I give and bequethe to Will[ia]m trevis Matthewe trevis sonne xij^d and allso to every one of his children xij^d apiece Allso I give and bequeathe to every one of John Trevis children xij^d apeace Allso I give and bequeathe to Will[ia]m Trevis vj^s viij^d Allso I give and bequeathe to Philippe Avery Richarde Averye and Edwarde Averye my brother Will[ia]ms sonnes xx^d a peace Allso I give and bequeathe to Katherine Newman xx^d It[e]m I give and bequeathe to my brother Will[ia]m Averie vj^s viij^d It[e]m I give and bequeathe to my syster Annes Crosley in monie and [stuffe??] fortie shillinges Allso I give to Katherine trevice my wyffes blacke fryce cassocke Allso all the rest of my goodes moveable and unmoveable I give & bequeathe to George Averye my sonne whom I doo make my wholle executor of this my last wyll and Testament Allso I doo make my ov[er]seers Michaell Chadwell Edward Walford Will[ia]m Avery & Thomas Newman of this my last will & Testament & Allso Will[ia]m Trevis made & wrytten in the p[re]sence of Michaell Chadwell Edward Walforde & Thomas Newman as wytnesses
